Today the cuts are worse and the tax hikes steeper than ever before! National Insurance has gone up. BEC has gone up and they even talking about charging you to collect your garbage! Things so tough that I even hear it cost more to buy tuna and grits in the morning - from .99 cents to \$2.99!
